THE FATS AND CHEESE (RATIONING) (BAILLWICK OF GUERNSEY)  
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1953.

Made ... .. 16th February, 1953.  
Coming into Operation. ... 18th February, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Fats and Cheese (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended as follows:-
  - (a) by inserting in the definition of cooking fats in paragraph (1) of Article 1 thereof immediately after the words "but shall not include" the words "hog grease (whether or not refined or bleached), fat resulting from the cooking of bacon or ham";
  - (b) by substituting in the definition of lard in paragraph (1) of Article 1 thereof for the words "but does not include unrefined or unbleached hog grease" the words "but does not include hog grease (whether or not refined or bleached) or fat resulting from the cooking of bacon or ham".
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Fats and Cheese (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 18th February, 1953.
