Export of Tomatoes Regulation 1953.

Made 10th March, 1953.

Coming into Operation 23rd March, 1953.

The Guernsey Tomato Marketing Board, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by The Tomato Marketing (Guernsey) Law, 1952, hereby makes the following regulations:-

Citation,
commencement
and inter-
pretation.

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Export of Tomatoes Regulations, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 23rd of March, 1953.

(2) In these regulations unless the context otherwise requires -

"Board" means the Guernsey Tomato Marketing Board;

"packer" means the person responsible for the packing of the tomatoes and for their delivery to the Board for export whether or not such person is the producer of the tomatoes concerned;

"export" means export by way of trade.

Packers'
Identification
numbers.

2. Every packer shall, on request, be issued by the Board with an identification number. An identification number issued by The Guernsey Tomato Shipping Board to a packer in 1952 shall be deemed to be an identification number issued to that packer by the Board for the purpose of complying with these regulations.

3. The packer's identification number shall be clearly stamped on both ends of every container of tomatoes delivered by him to the Board for export.

Advice
Notes and
Delivery.

4. At the time of delivering tomatoes to the Board for export, the carter shall deliver to the Board an advice note (on a form supplied by the Board) from the packer, countersigned by the carter, showing the total number of packages as well as the number of packages of each grade of tomatoes delivered for export by the packer. At the time of delivering the advice note to the Board the carter will be directed where to unload, and the delivery of the tomatoes to the Board shall be completed by their being unloaded in accordance with such directions.

Zoning

5. (1) For the purpose of prescribing the days on which tomatoes may be delivered to the Board for export the Island is hereby divided into two zones by a line drawn from the east coast via Grand Bouet, Vrangue, Rancee, Longue Rue, turning left along Landues du Maroche to the Chapel then via Sharruce Road and Carteret Road to the west coast. The portion of the Island lying to the north of that line is called the Northern Zone and the portion lying to the south of that line is called the Southern Zone.

(2) The Board will give notice in La Gazette Officielle from time to time of the days in the week on which tomatoes packed in the Northern Zone and tomatoes packed in the Southern Zone may be delivered for export.

Collection.

6. All tomatoes shall be packed ready for collection at the packer's premises by 8 a.m. on the day on which they are to be shipped.

Carters'

7. Tomatoes shall not be transported to the White Rock for delivery to the Board for export except by a carter licensed in that behalf by the Board.
