THE FUEL (MAXIMUM PRICES) (GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER, 1953.

Made 3rd March, 1953.
 Coming into Operation. ... 4th March, 1953.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1952 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended by substituting in the Schedule thereto for the maximum prices in relation to Coke, locally produced, the following:-

3. This Order may be cited as The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 4th day of March, 1953.
