IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946.

IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949.

AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated the 3rd August, 1949, (a), as amended, the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick, or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the Board of Administration.

Now, therefore, the Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. The Open General Import Licence dated the 23rd December, 1952, as amended, shall be further amended in accordance with Schedules I and II hereto.
2. This amendment shall take effect on the 16th day of April, 1953, and may be modified or revoked at any time by the Board of Administration.

Tissues, exceeding 18 inches in width, knitted or woven, wholly or mainly of cotton, broom fibre (genet), glass fibre, silk, artificial silk, linen, ramie, wool or mixtures of any of the foregoing materials; but not including:-

(a) tissues containing elastic, lace or lace net, or more than 5 per cent. of cashmere.

(b) felt.

(c) flat and hollow tubular braids, fringes and solid woven beltings.

(d) oil baize and leather cloth.

(e) silk bolting cloth.

Yarns and threads, wholly or mainly of artificial silk, cotton, flax, ramie, silk, wool other than goat hair, or mixtures of any of the foregoing materials.

Group 7 - Apparel, Footwear and Haberdashery.

Button blanks of non-metallic material, not polished, perforated or dyed.

Footwear of all types (not including stockings and socks) and parts thereof.

Gloves and glove linings, not containing lace or lace net.

Hat hoods, capelines, bodies, forms and shapes; but not including articles containing lace or lace net.

Laces, finished, for boots, shoes and corsets.
