IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER,
1949, AMENDMENT NO. 2. ORDER, 1953.

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The First Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a), as amended, shall be further amended by the deletion therefrom of the item:-

"Seed Grain of the following varieties:-
Barley, Maize, Oats, Wheat, where the consignment exceeds 28 lbs. in weight".
2. The Delegation of Power to Grant Import Licences (No. 1.) Order, 1949, (b), as amended, shall be further amended by the deletion therefrom of the item:-

"For Seed Grain, to the States' Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries".
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into force on the 16th day of April, 1953, and may be cited as the "Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 2. Order, 1953".

The effect of the above Order is that as from the 16th April, 1953, there will be no restrictions on the import from the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick and the Isle of Man of seed grain.
