Revocation Order

THE LINOLEUM AND PRINTED FELT BASE (MAXIMUM PRICES AND CHARGES)
(BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1953.

Made 17th April, 1953.

Coming into Operation. ... 19th April, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The following Orders are hereby revoked, but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof:-
 - (1) The Linoleum and Printed Felt Base (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, dated 7th July, 1951, (S.I. 1951 No. 88). ✓
 - (2) The Linoleum and Printed Felt Base (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1951, dated 23rd August, 1951, (S.I. 1951 No. 110). ✓
 - (3) The Linoleum and Printed Felt Base (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1951, dated 7th December, 1951, (S.I. 1951 No. 154). ✓
 - (4) The Linoleum and Printed Felt Base (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1952, dated 22nd March, 1952, (S.I. 1952 No. 78). ✓
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Linoleum and Printed Felt Base (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 19th day of April, 1953.
