IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949

AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated the 3rd August, 1949, (a), as amended, the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick, or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a Licence granted by or on behalf of the Board of Administration.

Now, therefore, the Board of Administration, in pursuance of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

- 1. Appendix VI of the Open General Import Licence dated 23rd December, 1952, shall be amended by adding the following thereto:-

"Holland

Flower bulbs, corms and tubers (excluding dahlia tubers)."

- 2. This amendment shall take effect on 1st May, 1953, and may be modified or revoked at any time by the Board of Administration.
