THE SUGAR (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1953.

Made ... .. 18th April, 1953.

Coming into Operation. ... 19th April, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended as follows:-
  - (a) by inserting in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (7) of Article 5 thereof after the words and figures "coupons numbered 1 or 3 or 4" the word and figure "or 13";
  - (b) by adding at the end of sub-paragraph (b) of the said paragraph (7) the words and figures "or the period from the 19th April, 1953, to 16th May, 1953, inclusive".
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 19th day of April, 1953.
