THE GENERAL FOOD (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 7) ORDER, 1953.

Made 16th May, 1953.

Coming into Operation. ... 17th May, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended as follows:-

(a) by substituting in Part IV - Sugar, of the said Schedule, the Part so numbered in the Schedule to this Order;

(b) by substituting in Part VII - Fats, of the said Schedule, for the maximum retail price per lb. of "2s. 6d." in relation to Butter, imported, the maximum retail price per lb. of "3s. 0d.";

(c) by substituting in Part IX - Flour, of the said Schedule, the Part so numbered in the Schedule to this Order;

(d) by substituting in Part X - Cheese, of the Said Schedule, for the maximum retail price per lb. of "1s. 4d." in relation to Processed Cheese and any other variety of Cheese to which the Fats and Cheese (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, applies, the maximum retail price per lb. of "2s. 0d.".

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

3. This Order may be cited as The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 7) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 17th day of May, 1953.
