The Plants and Potatoes Importation (No.3) Order, 1953.

The States of Guernsey Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section six of the Plants and Potatoes Importation Ordinance, 1951, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order: -

1. The Plants and Potatoes Importation (No.2) Order, 1953(a), of the 12th May, 1953, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") shall be amended by inserting in paragraph (iii) of section one thereof immediately after the words "raw fruit" the words "other than raw cherries".
2. The landing or transshipment in this Island of raw cherries from -
 - (i) any country other than a country in the Continent of Europe shall be permitted;
 - (ii) any country in the Continent of Europe other than Spain, Portugal, France, Italy, Austria, Bulgaria, Hungary, Yugoslavia, Switzerland, Czechoslovakia and Germany, shall be permitted provided that each consignment thereof is accompanied by a certificate signed by a duly authorised officer of the Government of the country of origin certifying the country and place where the raw cherries were grown;
 - (iii) France shall be permitted provided that each consignment thereof is accompanied by a certificate in the form set out in the Schedule to this Order and issued by an officer of the French Phytopathological Service.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 11th June, 1953, and shall expire on the 30th day of September, 1953, after which date the principal Order shall be read and have effect as if this Order had not been made.
