IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949
AMENDMENT NO. 3 ORDER, 1953

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. There shall be added to the Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated 3rd August, 1949, (a), the following item:-

"Flower bulbs, that is to say, bulbs, corms or rhizomes normally cultivated for their bloom or blossom, in consignments of more than 56 lbs."

2. There shall be added to the Delegation of Power to Grant Export Licences (No. 1) Order, 1949, dated 8th August, 1949, (b), the following words:-

"For Flower Bulbs, to the States' Committee for Horticulture".

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into force on 12th June, 1953, and may be cited as "The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 3 Order, 1953.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of this Order is that as from the 12th June, 1953, flower bulbs in consignments of more than 56 lbs. may not be exported to the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick or the Isle of Man except under licence granted by the States Committee for Horticulture.
