THE MEAT (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO 2)
ORDER, 1953.

Made 30th June, 1953.

Coming into Operation. ... 5th July, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended by adding at the end of Article 5 thereto the following:-

"(6) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order or in the Principal Order, where a surplus of meat is held by a retailer from meat supplied to him by a duly authorised agent of the Committee for supply to his registered customers or to establishments or Group III manufacturers, after having supplied the lawful requirements of those customers, establishments and manufacturers, the retailer may supply any such surplus meat to any person ration free, and any person may obtain any such meat from the retailer ration free".

- 2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
- 3. This Order may be cited as the Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 5th day of July, 1953.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order, which comes into operation on 5th July, 1953, frees from rationing any surplus meat held by retailers out of their allocations after having satisfied the lawful requirements of their registered customers and establishments and certain manufacturers they are authorised to supply.
