THE SUGAR (RATIONING) (BAILIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER,
1953.

Made 6th July, 1953.

Coming into Operation. ... 9th August, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953 (a) shall be amended as follows:-
 - (a) by deleting therefrom paragraph (7) of Article 5;
 - (b) by deleting paragraph 2 of the notes to the Schedule to the Order.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 9th day of August, 1953.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953, provided that holders of Ration Books R.B.1 and R.B.2 and Temporary Ration Cards R.B.12 could obtain an extra 1 lb. of sugar during each of the four-week ration periods Nos. 1, 2 and 3 (ending 8th August, 1953).

This amending Order continues the above provisions until further notice, during each four-week ration period after 8th August, 1953.
