IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949  
AMENDMENT NO. 4 ORDER, 1953

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of its powers under the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a) shall be amended by the deletion therefrom of the following items:-

"Feeding-stuffs for animals"

"Feeding-stuffs for poultry"

2. The Delegation of Power to Grant Export Licences (No. 1) Order, 1949, (b) shall be amended by the deletion therefrom of the words:-

"For Feeding-stuffs for animals and poultry, to the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries".

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into force on the 10th day of August, 1953, and may be cited as "The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 4 Order, 1953."

The effect of the above Order is that as from the 10th August, 1953, there will be no restrictions on the exportation to the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick and the Isle of Man of feeding-stuffs for animals and poultry.
