THE FUEL (MAXIMUM PRICES) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1953.

Made ... .. 31st July, 1953.

Coming into Operation ... 1st August, 1953.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. (a) In this Order -

"Buy" includes offer or agree to buy and "sell" includes offer or agree to sell or expose for sale.

"Imported" means imported from the United Kingdom.

(b) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

2. No person shall buy or sell any fuel of a description appearing in the Schedule to this Order at a price exceeding the price applicable thereto in accordance with the provisions of the said Schedule.

3. This Order shall not apply in relation to fuel for use for Horticultural purposes.

4. The following Orders are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof:-

(a) The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1952, dated 1st August, 1952 (a).

(b) The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1952, dated 15th August, 1952 (b).

(c) The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1952, dated 8th December, 1952 (c).

(d) The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1953, dated 3rd March, 1953 (d).

5. This Order may be cited as The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of August, 1953.
