THE MEAT (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 3)  
ORDER, 1953.

Made ... .. 14th August, 1953.

Coming into Operation. ... 16th August, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended by substituting for paragraph (6) of Article 5 thereof the following:-

"(6) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order or in the Principal Order -

(a) where a surplus of meat is held by a retailer from meat supplied to him by a duly authorised agent of the Committee for supply to his registered customers or to establishments or Group III manufacturers, after having supplied the lawful requirements of those customers, establishments and manufacturers the retailer may supply any such surplus meat to any person ration free, and any person may obtain any such meat from the retailer ration free;

(b) where any retailer of meat products, being a Group IV manufacturer, is supplied with pork by a duly authorised agent of the Committee free from any condition or stipulation that it be processed that retailer may either process the pork or sell it unprocessed to any person ration free and any person may obtain any such pork from the retailer ration free".

- 2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
- 3. The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1953 (c) is hereby revoked, but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention of the Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953, as amended thereby.
- 4. This Order may be cited as the Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 16th day of August, 1953.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order, which comes into operation on 16th August, 1953, permits certain retailers who are Group IV manufacturers (pork butchers) to sell ration free, unprocessed, any pork which is supplied to them by the Committee's authorised agent free from any requirement that it be processed.
