THE FATS AND CHEESE (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)  
(AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER, 1953.

Coming into Operation. ... 23rd August, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Fats and Cheese (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended as follows:-

(a) by substituting in paragraph (1) of Article 1 thereof for the definitions of cooking fats and lard respectively the following definitions:-

"'Cooking fats' means any mixture fit for human food or for use in the manufacture, preparation or treatment of human food, consisting of two or more oils specified in the Second Schedule to the Oils and Fats (No. 2) Order, 1953, of the United Kingdom, or of one or more of the said oils mixed with any other oil or fat, and having a melting point which when determined by the method specified in the Fourth Schedule to the said Oils and Fats (No. 2) Order, 1953, of the United Kingdom, is not less than 30 degrees centigrade; it does not include margarine, but does include lard as hereinafter defined.

'Lard' means rendered fat derived from a pig and having a melting point which when determined by the method specified in the Fourth Schedule to the said Oils and Fats (No. 2) Order, 1953, of the United Kingdom, is not less than 25 degrees centigrade, but does not include hog grease (whether or not refined or bleached) or fat resulting from the cooking of bacon, ham or pork";

(b) by inserting in proviso (c) to Article 4 thereof immediately after the words "ration period No. 2, No. 3 or No. 4" the words "No. 5 or No. 6".

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

3. This Order may be cited as the Fats and Cheese (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 23rd day of August, 1953.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order, which comes into operation on 23rd August, 1953:-

- (a) revises the definition of cooking fats so as to exclude therefrom all oils and fats other than lard and mixtures containing any oil named in the Second Schedule to the Oils and Fats (No. 2) Order, 1953, of the United Kingdom;
- (b) revises the definition of lard so as to free from the rationing scheme fat resulting from the cooking of pork;
- (c) maintains at 4 oz. for a further eight weeks (6th September, 1953, to 31st October, 1953, inclusive) the butter ration obtainable against appropriate coupons in Ration Books R.B.1 and R.B.2 and Temporary Ration Cards R.B.12.
