THE FUEL (MAXIMUM PRICES) (GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1953.

Made 14th September, 1953.

Coming into Operation ... 16th September, 1953.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1953, (a) shall be amended by substituting in the Schedule thereto for the maximum prices in relation to Anthracite Nuts and Phurnacite, the following:-

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 16th day of September, 1953.

This Order increases the maximum prices of Anthracite Nuts and Phurnacite for use other than for Horticultural purposes by 6d. per cwt. to 9s. 6d. per cwt. delivered and 9s. 0d. per cwt. ex Merchants' Stores.
