GENERAL LICENCE DATED 29th SEPTEMBER, 1953, MADE BY THE
STATES OF GUERNSEY COMMITTEE FOR THE CONTROL OF ESSENTIAL
COMMODITIES UNDER THE FLOUR (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
ORDER, 1953.

Pursuant to Article 8 of the Flour (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953, the States of Guernsey Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities hereby authorises:-

1. That notwithstanding the provisions of the Flour (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953, the Charroterie Mills Ltd., St. Peter Port, may manufacture and sell and any person in the Bailiwick of Guernsey may buy, sell or supply for a period of twenty-eight days from the date of this Licence, flour which does not contain the required compulsory additions as set out in the Schedule to the Order.
2. This Licence shall come into operation on the 29th September, 1953.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Licence provides for the manufacture and sale of flour by the Charroterie Mills Ltd. without the compulsory addition of Creta Praeparata in all flours, and Iron, Vitamin B1 and Nicotinic Acid in flours of an extraction rate less than 80%. It also permits the buying, selling or supplying of such flour within the Bailiwick but does not permit the importation of such flour and is operated to enable the Charroterie Mills Ltd. to install the machinery required in the manufacture of flour in accordance with the provisions of the Flour (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953.
