THE SUGAR (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (REVOCATION)  
ORDER, 1953.

Made ... .. 26th September, 1953.

Coming into Operation ... 27th September, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The following Orders are hereby revoked, but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof:-
  - (1) The Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953, dated 17th May, 1953, (S.I. 1953 No. 68) (a).
  - (2) The Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1953, dated 6th July, 1953, (S.I. 1953 No. 79) (b).
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 27th day of September, 1953, and may be cited as the Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1953.
