THE FOOD RATIONING (GENERAL PROVISIONS) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1953.

Made 26th September, 1953.

Coming into Operation ... 27th September, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953 (a), shall be amended as follows:-
 - (a) by deleting from the Order paragraph 2 of Article 1 thereof;
 - (b) by deleting from paragraph (1) of Article 10 thereof the words "or hot beverage";
 - (c) by deleting paragraph (5) of Article 11 thereof;
 - (d) by deleting from sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (9) of Article 11 thereof the words "and 'monthly coupons'", "respectively" and "and to a ration period";
 - (e) by deleting from sub-paragraph (a) (i) of paragraph (1) of Article 13 thereof the words "and hot beverages" and "or hot beverages".
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 27th day of September, 1953, and may be cited as the Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1953.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order -

- (a) frees licensees of establishments from the necessity for keeping a record of hot beverages served; and
- (b) consequent upon the derationing of sugar, removes the requirement, now inoperative, that residential establishments shall cancel monthly coupons in residents' ration books.
