THE FATS AND CHEESE (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 4) ORDER, 1953.

Made 23rd October, 1953.

Coming into Operation ... 1st November, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Fats and Cheese (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended as follows:-
 - (a) by deleting the proviso to Article 4 thereof;
 - (b) by substituting for the Schedule thereto the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. The following Orders are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention of the Fats and Cheese (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953, as amended thereby:-
 - (1) The Fats and Cheese (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1953 (c).
 - (2) The Fats and Cheese (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1953 (d).
4. This Order may be cited as the Fats and Cheese (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 4) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of November, 1953.

AMOUNT OF THE RATION.

Where a form R.G.48 or R.G.48E relating to any rationed food is produced with a ration document the amount obtainable during the period of validity of such form against each appropriate coupon for that food -

- (a) in the case of a form relating to cheese, shall be the amount specified on the form, or, where no amount is so specified shall be 12 oz. for each special ration specified on the form. In each case the amount is in lieu of that specified in the table above;

(b) in any other case, shall be increased as specified on the form.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order, which comes into force on 1st November, 1953:-

- (a) increases the cheese ration obtainable against appropriate coupons in a General Ration Book R.B.1, Child's Ration Book R.B.2 and a Temporary Ration Card R.B.12 from $1\frac{1}{2}$ oz. to 2 oz;
- (b) increases from 4 oz. to 6 oz. the amount of margarine obtainable against each appropriate coupon in a General Ration Book R.B.1 and a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 relating to the week beginning 8th November, 1953 (week No. 26) and to each alternate week thereafter. The ration for each other week remains at 4 oz;
- (c) increases the amount of margarine obtainable against an appropriate coupon in a Temporary Ration Card R.B.12 from 4 oz. to 5 oz.
