THE IMPORTED ANIMAL FEEDINGSTUFFS (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK
 OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1953.

Made 26th October, 1953.

Coming into Operation ... 1st November, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. (1) In this Order -

"Committee" means as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney, the States of Guernsey Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, and as regards the Island of Alderney, the Alderney Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities;

"Animal" means any heifer aged not more than twelve months, any cow and any bull;

"Feedingstuff" means a mixture of substances used as a complete ration for feeding to an animal or a mixture of substances of high protein content manufactured for the purpose of being mixed with other substances for the production of a complete ration for feeding to an animal for any of the following purposes:-

- (a) in the case of heifers, for rearing the heifers;
- (b) in the case of cows, for producing milk;
- (c) in the case of bulls, for feeding the bulls;

provided that the composition of such ration shall conform to the Committee's standards;

"Owner" shall be deemed to include the person authorised by the owner to obtain subsidised feedingstuffs on his behalf;

"Sale by retail" means any sale to a person buying otherwise than for the purpose of re-sale, and the expression "sell by retail" shall be construed accordingly;

"Supply" and "acquisition" shall be construed as including agreeing or offering to supply or acquire and as so construed shall include the disposal and acquisition of -

- (a) ownership or any proprietary interests; or
- (b) the right to possession; or

- (c) possession whether or not accompanied by any disposal or acquisition of ownership or of any proprietary interest or of the right of possession.
- (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
2. Except under and in accordance with the terms of a general or special licence granted by the Committee no person shall sell feedingstuffs by retail and a person to whom such a licence has been granted is hereinafter referred to in this Order as a "licensed retail merchant".
 3. The Committee shall keep a register of all owners of animals in respect of which the supply of feedingstuffs shall be authorised by it under the provisions of this Order.
 4. The Committee may by notice in the Gazette Officielle or by individual direction prescribe the form in or on which any application is to be made, notice given and records kept under the provisions of this Order and in or on such prescribed form may vary any information required to be shown in relation thereto under such provision.
 5. Where the owner of any animals has declared to the Committee the number of animals which he owns and on or after the coming into force of this Order any change is made in the number so declared then he shall, within seven days of such change, notify the Committee in writing thereof.
 6. An owner of animals shall obtain the feedingstuffs to which he is entitled from time to time only from the licensed retail merchant with whom he is registered by the Committee for feedingstuffs.
 7. For the purposes of Article 6 of this Order registration of an owner of animals shall be effected by the Committee notifying in writing a licensed retail merchant from time to time that he is authorised to supply feedingstuffs to the owner thereof and the quantity of feedingstuffs to which the said owner shall be entitled in respect of each class of animals owned by him.
 8. Every licensed retail merchant shall -
 - (a) keep a record in such form as the Committee may from time to time direct showing the name and address of every owner of animals registered with him for feedingstuffs showing separately each class of animal and details of all feedingstuffs supplied by him; and
 - (b) when so required by the Committee furnish such particulars and produce such books, accounts and documents relating to his dealings in and stocks of feedingstuffs as may be required by the said Committee.
 9. Infringements against this Order or against any direction given thereunder are offences against the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945.
 10. The following Orders are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof:-
 - (1) The Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated 12th December, 1949 (a).
 - (2) The Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1950, dated 1st July, 1950 (b).

- (3) The Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1951, dated 13th July, 1951 (c).
 - (4) The Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1952, dated 27th August, 1952 (d).
 - (5) The Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 4) Order, 1952, dated 6th October, 1952 (e).
 - (6) The Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 5) Order, 1953, dated 9th January, 1953 (f).
11. This Order may be cited as the Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of November, 1953.
