Revocation Order

THE WASTE OF FOOD (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (REVOCAATION)
ORDER, 1953.

Made 30th October, 1953.

Coming into Operation ... 5th November, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Waste of Food Order dated 21st March, 1946, is hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Waste of Food (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 5th day of November, 1953.
