THE MEAT (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(NO. 2) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1953.

Made 14th November, 1953.

Coming into Operation ... 15th November, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Meat (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) Order, 1953 (a) shall be amended by substituting in Paragraph 1 of Article 1 in the definition of "locally produced pork", for the words "Bailiwick of Guernsey" the words "Channel Islands".
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Meat (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) (Amendment) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 15th day of November, 1953.
