The Poultry Carcasses (Importation) Order, 1953.

The States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph (d) of section two of the Poultry Carcasses Importation Ordinance, 1951, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order: -

1. Subject to the succeeding provisions of this Order the importation into this Island of an eviscerated poultry carcase from any of the departments of France specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be permitted.
2. An eviscerated carcase imported under the provisions of the last preceding section shall be accompanied by a certificate, which shall be delivered to the States Supervisor by the importer, signed by a veterinary officer of the French Ministry of Agriculture, to the effect that the carcase is from poultry which, for a period of eight weeks prior to importation has been kept in an establishment free from fowl pest and situate during that period not less than twenty kilometres from any outbreak of fowl pest.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 3rd December, 1953.
