IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949

AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated the 3rd August, 1949, (a), as amended, the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick, or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the Board of Administration.

Now, therefore, the Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. The Open General Import Licence dated the 23rd December, 1952, as amended, shall be further amended in accordance with the Schedule hereto.
2. This amendment shall take effect on the 10th day of December, 1953, and may be modified or revoked at any time by the Board of Administration.

Group 1 - Part A - Food, Drink, Animal Feeding Stuffs and Seeds

- Corned beef hash.
- Corned beef loaf.
- Corned beef with cereal.
- Ham, chopped, containing no pieces exceeding half an inch in any dimension.
- Ham loaf.
- Irish stew.
- Lambs' tongue.
- Lunch tongue.
- Luncheon beef with cereal.
- Meat hash.
- Meat lunch.
- Meat and vegetable.
- Meat and vegetable stew.
- Minced beef loaf.
- Minced meat loaf.
- Ox tongue.
- Pate de foie.
- Potted meat.
- Pork, chopped, containing no pieces exceeding half an inch in any dimension.

NOTE: Importers of the above meat and meat products are reminded that imports are subject to the requirements imposed under the "Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952".

APPENDIX IX

Goods which can be imported without separate licences if consigned from and originating in any country or territory other than:-

Albania, Argentina, Bolivia, Bulgaria, Canada, Columbia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Czechoslovakia, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, French Somaliland, Germany (Russian Zone), Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Hungary, Japan, Korea, Liberia, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Persia (Iran), Philippines, Poland, Roumania, Spain (including the Balearic and the Canary Islands), Spanish West Africa (including Fernando Po), Spanish Ports in North Africa, the Spanish Zone of Morocco, Tangier, United States of America, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, Venezuela.

Nuts, edible, shelled or unshelled, excluding peanuts.
