THE FOOD (LICENSING OF WHOLESALERS) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 6) ORDER, 1953.

Made 7th December, 1953.

Coming into Operation ... 9th December, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. The Food (Licensing of Wholesalers) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended by deleting from the Schedule thereto, the following entries:-

"Butter".

"Cheese" as defined in the Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended.

"Sugar".

"Syrup and treacle".

- 2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
- 3. This Order may be cited as the Food (Licensing of Wholesalers) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 6) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 9th day of December, 1953.
