The Shorthand Notes and Transcripts (Criminal Cases) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Rules, 2012

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 41(2) of the Court of Appeal (Guernsey) Law, 1961¹, hereby orders:-

Amendment of 1964 Rules

1. The Shorthand Notes and Transcripts (Criminal Cases) (Guernsey) Rules, 1964², as amended³,-
 - (a) In Rule 5(1)(a), for the words following "that person," substitute "in respect of each A4 side or part thereof, the sum of £10";
 - (b) In Rule 5(1)(b), for the words following "that person," substitute "in respect of each A4 side or part thereof, the sum of £1.50"

- (c) In Rule 5A⁴, for "£20" substitute "£45" and following the words "access to such recording is granted." at the end of paragraph 5A, add "A fee of £25 for each hour or part thereof shall be payable if the recording is held in digital format."
