

## STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

*Revised - on S.I. 115 (1952)*THE FATS, CHEESE AND TEA (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)  
(AMENDMENT No. 2) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a), as amended (b), shall be further amended by deleting therefrom Article 9 thereof.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 30th day of December, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order, by removing the restriction in Article 9 of the principal Order, enables consumers to purchase tea, within their ration entitlement, on more than one occasion during any ration period of four weeks.
