

## STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

THE FOOD RATIONING (GENERAL PROVISIONS) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. (1) The Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a), as amended (b), shall be further amended by deleting from Article 9 thereof the proviso thereto which requires the use by establishments of Forms M.5 in relation to all meat obtained by them under the authority of Forms S.A.1 or E.A.2/S.A.2.
- (2) Any provision in a Form S.A.1 or Form E.A.2/S.A.2 requiring an establishment to use a Form M.5 in respect of meat received after the date this Order comes into operation shall have no effect.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 30th day of December, 1951.
