THE UTILITY CLOTH AND UTILITY HOUSEHOLD TEXTILES (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (NO. 2) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:--

1. The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) Order, 1951 (a) as amended (b) shall have effect subject to the following amendments:--
 - (a) by substituting in Article 1 (1) thereof for the words "cloth (hereinafter called "goods")", the word "goods";
 - (b) for the First Schedule thereto there shall be substituted the Schedule to this Order; and
 - (c) in Part I of the Second Schedule thereto item 17, utility blankets of wool or other animal fibre, shall be omitted.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order, as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 3rd day of December, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) Order, 1951, as amended.

Retailers' maximum prices for utility blankets of wool or other animal fibre are no longer to be computed by adding a percentage margin to the purchase price, but are now to be computed by reference to the cash maximum prices set out in the Schedule to this Order.
