

## STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1952 No. 26

THE UTILITY GABERDINE RAINCOATS (DISTRIBUTORS' MAXIMUM PRICES AND CHARGES) (BAILLICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The maximum price to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer on a sale of new utility goods being a garment of any description specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto shall be the appropriate amount specified in that Part in relation to that description with the addition of 2½ per cent thereof.
2. The variations of maximum prices specified in Part II of the Schedule hereto shall have effect as therein provided.
3. (1) The maximum charge to be made in the course of the business of a retailer who performs the service of carrying out or contracting to carry out alterations to a garment to which this Order applies, being a garment sold by him, within a period of three months from the date of the sale thereof, shall be -
  - (i) in respect of a garment which was not made to measure -
    - (a) the actual cost to the retailer of such alterations, or
    - (b) the sum of 15s., whichever is the less;
  - (ii) in respect of a garment which was made to measure, the sum of 1d.
- (2) All alterations to which this Article applies shall be separately charged.
- (3) In this Article "a garment" means, in relation to a garment comprising two or more articles, all such articles.
4. Each specification number specified in the second column of Part I of the Schedule hereto refers to utility goods being a garment to which that number (or that number preceded by the letter "X" or "Z") has been applied in pursuance of an Order made by the Board of Trade of the United Kingdom.
5. (1) In this Order -
 

"maximum price" means the price from which the cost actually paid or incurred in delivering those garments may be excluded, payable before any deductions by way of discount;

"utility goods" has the meaning assigned in The Apparel and Textiles (Guernsey) Order, 1945, as amended.
- (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

6. This Order may be cited as The Utility Gaberdine Raincoats (Distributors' Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 21st day of January, 1952.

In this Part -

- 1. A double breasted raincoat means a raincoat having a wrap-over and carrying a double row of buttons, the button stand being not less than 6 inches.
- 2. The reference to "hoods" in items 3 and 4 of Part I includes both fixed and detachable hoods made from cloth of the same specification number as that of the cloth from which the raincoat or trench coat is made.

PART II.

VARIATIONS IN MAXIMUM PRICES.

Women's and Maids' raincoats with detachable hoods.

- 1. On the sale of a woman's or maid's raincoat of a specification number specified in the following Table being a raincoat with a detachable hood, the appropriate maximum price shall be increased by the appropriate amount specified in the Table in relation to that specification number:-

Made-to-measure raincoats.

2. On the sale of a raincoat of a description specified in the following Table which has been made up at the request of the purchaser to measurements given by him to the seller and which has been cut singly by a special order cutter, the appropriate maximum price (as varied by the provisions of paragraph 1 of this Part, where they are applicable) shall be increased by the appropriate amount specified in the Table in relation to that description:-

Special and outside raincoats.

3. (1) The appropriate maximum price (as varied by the provisions of paragraph 1 or 2 of this Part, where they are applicable) shall -
- (a) on the sale of a man's outside raincoat which has been made up at the request of the purchaser to measurements given by him to the seller and which has been cut singly by a special order cutter, or on the sale of a special raincoat, be increased by 15 per cent thereof;
  - (b) on the sale of a man's outside garment (not made up as indicated in head (a) of this sub-paragraph) be increased by 10 per cent thereof;
  - (c) on the sale of a woman's or maid's raincoat of a description specified in the first column of the following Table, be increased by the percentage thereof specified in the second column in relation to that description -

(2) in this paragraph -

"outsized raincoat" means a raincoat to fit a man having a chest measurement (measured over the waistcoat) exceeding 42 ins.;

"special raincoat" means a raincoat exceeding 48 ins. in length which has been made up at the request of the purchaser to measurements, appropriate to a man not less than 6 ft. 3 ins. in height, given by the purchaser to the seller and which has been cut singly by a special order cutter.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order fixes retailers' maximum prices for the utility gaberdine raincoats described in Part I of the Schedule. Hitherto retailers' maximum prices for these goods have been fixed by The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951. Retailers' maximum prices are now based on the amounts specified in Part I of the Schedule, whereas hitherto they have been fixed by reference to the purchase price and the appropriate margin, subject to overriding maximum prices. The maximum prices now fixed are the same as the former overriding maximum prices specified in Related Schedule No. 16D.
