THE UTILITY APPAREL (MAXIMUM PRICES AND CHARGES)

(BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 8)

ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a) as amended (b) shall have effect subject to the following amendments:-

(a) for Article 1 there shall be substituted the following article:-

"1. (1) The maximum prices to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer in respect of utility goods being apparel of a description and bearing a specification number specified in the First Schedule hereto shall be the amount therein specified in relation to that description and specification number with the addition of 2½ per cent thereof.

(2) The maximum prices to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer in respect of utility goods to which paragraph 1 of this Article does not apply and for which retailers' maximum prices are not for the time being fixed by any Order made under Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, shall be the aggregate of the following amounts:-

(a) the price paid or agreed to be paid to the manufacturer or wholesaler, by the first purchaser, being a retailer;

(b) an amount equal to the appropriate percentage of such price specified in Column 2 of the Second Schedule; and

(c) an amount equal to 2½ per cent of the aggregate of the foregoing amounts;

so, however, that in respect of goods of the descriptions specified in Column 1 of the appropriate Part of the relevant Related Schedule, the maximum price computed in accordance with paragraph (2) of this Article shall not exceed the appropriate amount specified in Column 3 of such Schedule, with the addition of 2½ per cent of such amount."

(b) for the Second Schedule there shall be substituted the Schedule to this Order;

(c) in the Third Schedule the reference to Related Schedule 16D shall be omitted.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

3. This Order may be cited as The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 8) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 21st day of January, 1952.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, as amended ("the principal Order") which fixes retailers' maximum prices for utility apparel.

The principal change is the exclusion from the scope of the principal Order of all utility apparel for which retailers' maximum prices are fixed by any other Order made under Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945.

Three such Orders come into operation on the same date as this Order; they are -

- (a) The Women's and Maids' Utility Outerwear (Distributors' Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952.
- (b) The Utility Gaberdine Raincoats (Distributors' Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952.
- (c) The Men's, Youths' and Boys' Utility Outerwear (Distributors' Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952.
