THE WOMEN'S AND MAIDS' UTILITY OUTERWEAR (DISTRIBUTORS' MAXIMUM PRICES AND CHARGES (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Women's and Maids' Utility Outerwear (Distributors' Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952 (a), shall have effect as if for the maximum price "176s. 3d." specified in the third column in item 4 of Part I of the Schedule in relation to Group X there were substituted the maximum price "196s. 3d."
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Women's and Maids' Utility Outerwear (Distributors' Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of February, 1952.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order amends the Women's and Maids' Utility Outerwear (Distributors' Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, by correcting an error in the maximum price on a sale by retail for women's or maids' costumes of the specification numbers comprised in Group X.
