THE MEAT (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT
NO. 11) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a), as amended (b), shall be further amended by substituting for paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Schedule thereto (which specifies the amount of the meat ration) the following paragraphs:-

- "1. Amount against the appropriate coupons relating to each week in a -

General Ration Book R.B.1	} 1s. 3d. maximum price (7½d. maximum retail price for each coupon) or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey 2s. 10d. maximum price (1s. 5d. maximum retail price for each coupon).
Form R.B.12	

2. Amount against each appropriate coupon in a -

Child's Ration Book R.B.2	} 7½d. maximum retail price or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey 1s. 5d. maximum retail price."
Ration Book R.B.7	
Leave or Duty Ration	
Card R.B.8A	

2. For the avoidance of doubt, the maximum quantity of meat which may be obtained or supplied against an appropriate coupon for meat in any of the ration documents mentioned in Article 1 of this Order relating to the week beginning 20th January, 1952, and valid for use during the said week and the following week, but not used during the said week beginning 20th January, 1952, shall be the maximum retail price applicable in relation thereto immediately prior to the coming into operation of this Order.
3. The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 10) Order, 1951, dated the 9th November, 1951 (c), and the Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Directions, 1951, dated the 15th December, 1951 (d), are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention of the Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, as amended or affected thereby.
4. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
5. This Order may be cited as the Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 11) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 27th day of January, 1952.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This amending Order reduces, as from 27th January, 1952, the amount of the meat ration which may be obtained against appropriate coupons in a Ration Book R.B.1 and Form R.B.12 from 1s. 6d. to 1s. 3d. maximum retail price, or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey from 3s. 0d. to 2s. 10d. maximum retail price. The value of appropriate coupons in a Child's Ration Book R.B.2, Ration Book R.B.7 and Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A is reduced from 9d. to 7½d. or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey from 1s. 6d. to 1s. 5d. maximum retail price.

Coupons for the week beginning 20th January, 1952, but not used in that week, remain valid, if used in the week beginning 27th January, 1952, for the maximum retail price applicable in relation thereto immediately prior to this Order coming into operation.

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
