THE INFANTS' AND GIRLS' UTILITY HEAVY OUTERWEAR (DISTRIBUTORS' MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The maximum price to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer on a sale of new utility goods being a garment of any description specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto shall be the appropriate amount specified in that Part in relation to that description with the addition of $2\frac{1}{2}$ per cent thereof.
2. The variations of maximum prices specified in Part II of the Schedule hereto shall have effect as therein provided.
3. (1) Each specification number specified or referred to in the second column of Part I of the Schedule hereto refers to utility goods being a garment to which that number (or that number preceded by the letter "X" or "Z") has been applied in pursuance of an Order made by the Board of Trade of the United Kingdom.
(2) Each group figure specified in the second column of Part I of the Schedule hereto has the meaning assigned thereto in Part III thereof.
4. (1) In this Order -
"maximum price" means the price from which the cost actually paid or incurred of delivering those garments may be excluded payable before any deductions by way of discount.
"utility goods" has the meaning assigned in the Apparel and Textiles (Guernsey) Order, 1945, as amended.
(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
5. This Order may be cited as the Infants' and Girls' Utility Heavy Outerwear (Distributors' Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 4th day of February, 1952.

PART II.

Variations of Maximum Prices.

- On the sale of a garment of a description mentioned in the following Table, the maximum price shall, in the case of such a garment being made with corded or bound edges, or with a badge on the breast pocket, be increased by the appropriate amount set out below in relation to the garment and shall, in the case of the garment being made both with such edges and with such badge, be increased by twice that amount -

- On the sale of a girls' blazer or overcoat which -
 - is not of stock size, that is, a size usually made by the manufacturer ready-to-wear, and
 - cannot be produced by minor adaptations to a garment of such a size, and
 - has been made up at the request of the purchaser to measurements given by him to the seller and has been cut singly by a special order cutter,

the maximum price shall be the amount specified in Part I in relation to the nearest stock size (as varied by the provisions of paragraph 1 of this Part, where they are applicable) increased by 12½ per cent thereof.

The nearest stock size shall be computed by reference to chest measurements for blazers and by reference to lengths for overcoats.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order fixes retailers' maximum prices for the infants' and girls' utility heavy outerwear described in Part I of the Schedule. Hitherto retailers' maximum prices for these articles have been fixed by the Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951. Retailers' maximum prices are now based on the amounts specified in Part I of the Schedule, whereas hitherto they have been fixed by reference to the purchase price and the appropriate margin.
