THE GENERAL FOOD (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 8) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a), as amended (b), shall be further amended by substituting for Part VI - Syrup and Treacle, of the Schedule thereto, the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 8) Order, 1951, and shall come into force on the 22nd January, 1952.

THE SCHEDULE.

PART VI - SYRUP AND TREACLE.

<u>Description.</u>	<u>Container.</u>	<u>Maximum Retail Price.</u>
Syrup and Treacle.	Tins or cartons containing 1 lb. net weight.	s. d. 11 per tin or carton.
Syrup and Treacle.	Tins or cartons containing 1 lb. 9 oz. net weight.	1 4½ per tin or carton.
Syrup and Treacle.	Tins or cartons containing 2 lbs. net weight.	1 9 per tin or carton.
Syrup and Treacle.	Tins or cartons containing 4 lbs. net weight.	3 5 per tin or carton.
Syrup and Treacle.	Glass jars containing not more than 1 lb. net weight.	At the rate of 11½ per lb.
Syrup and Treacle.	Glass jars containing not more than 1 lb. net weight but less than 4 lbs. net weight.	At the rate of 11 per lb.
Syrup and Treacle.	When not sold in a container or when sold in any container other than a container specified above.	At the rate of 9½ per lb.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order increases the maximum retail prices of syrup and treacle by 1d. per lb.
