THE FUEL (MAXIMUM PRICES) (GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1952 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended by substituting in the Schedule thereto for the maximum prices in relation to Anthracite Peas, the following:-

"Maximum Prices per cwt.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1952, and shall come into force on the 8th day of December, 1952.
