THE SOAP (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF  
GUERNSEY) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The following Orders are hereby revoked, but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof:-
  - (1) The Soap (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, dated 7th August, 1951 (S.I. 1951 No. 119). ✓
  - (2) The Soap (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1951, dated 14th September, 1951 (S.I. 1951 No. 125). ✓
  - (3) The Soap (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1951, dated 9th October, 1951 (S.I. 1951 No. 139). ✓
  - (4) The Soap (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1952, dated 8th January, 1952 (S.I. 1952 No. 16). ✓
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Soap (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 8th day of February, 1952.
