THE UTILITY OILSKINS (DISTRIBUTORS' MAXIMUM PRICES)  
(BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The maximum price to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer on a sale of new utility goods, being a garment of any description specified in the Schedule hereto shall be the appropriate amount specified in that Schedule in relation to that description with the addition of 2½ per cent thereof.
2. Each specification number specified in the second column of the Schedule hereto refers to utility goods being a garment to which that number (or that number preceded by the letter "Z") has been applied in pursuance of an Order made by the Board of Trade of the United Kingdom.
3. (1) In this Order -  
"maximum price" means the price from which the cost actually paid or incurred of delivering those garments may be excluded payable before any deductions by way of discount;  
"utility goods" has the meaning assigned in The Apparel and Textiles (Guernsey) Order, 1945, as amended.  
(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
4. This Order may be cited as The Utility Oilskins (Distributors' Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 3rd day of March, 1952.

In this Schedule "Marked XX" refers to a garment in which the seams have been painted with drying oils to cover all stitch holes and which has been marked with the letters "XX" in pursuance of an Order made by the Board of Trade of the United Kingdom.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order fixes retailers' maximum prices for the utility oilskins described in the Schedule. Hitherto retailers' maximum prices for these articles have been fixed by The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952. Retailers' maximum prices are now based on the amounts specified in the Schedule, whereas hitherto they have been fixed by reference to the purchase price and the appropriate margin.
