THE UTILITY CURTAIN CLOTH AND UTILITY UPHOLSTERY CLOTH
(DISTRIBUTORS' MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF
GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey, excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The maximum price to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer on a sale of new utility goods being woven cloth of any description specified in the Schedule hereto, shall be the appropriate amount specified in that Schedule in relation to that description with the addition of $2\frac{1}{2}$ per cent thereof.
2. The variations of maximum prices specified in Part III of the Schedule hereto shall have effect as therein provided.
3. Each specification number specified in sub-column (a) of column 1 of the Schedule hereto refers to utility goods being cloth to which that specification number has been applied in pursuance of an Order made by the Board of Trade of the United Kingdom.

4. (1) In this Order -

"maximum price" means the price from which the cost actually paid or incurred of delivering those utility goods may be excluded payable before any deduction by way of discount;

"utility goods" has the meaning assigned in The Apparel and Textiles (Guernsey) Order, 1945, as amended.

- (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

This Order may be cited as The Utility Curtain Cloth and Utility Upholstery Cloth (Distributors' Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 25th day of February, 1952.

PART III.

1. The maximum prices specified in relation to any utility goods in section 1 of Part I, or in section 1 of Part II, of this Schedule shall be increased -

(a) where the utility goods bear a specification number preceded by the letter and symbol "R/" or "P/", by 15 per cent thereof;

(b) where the utility goods bear a specification number preceded by the letter and symbol "E/", by 30 per cent thereof.

PART III (Contd.)

2. The maximum prices specified in relation to any utility goods in Part I of this Schedule (increased where appropriate in accordance with paragraph 1 of this Part) shall be reduced by 20 per cent thereof where the utility goods bear the word "seconds".
3. The maximum prices specified in relation to any utility goods in section 2 of Part I of this Schedule (reduced where appropriate in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2 of this Part) shall -
 - (a) where the width of the cloth is less than 40 inches, be increased by 5 per cent thereof and then varied proportionately to the relation between the width of the cloth and 48 inches;
 - (b) where the width of the cloth is not less than 40 inches, and is not 48 inches, be varied proportionately to the relation between the width of the cloth and 48 inches.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order fixes retailers' maximum prices for utility curtain cloth and utility upholstery cloth described in the Schedule to this Order; retailers' maximum prices for such cloths, which have hitherto been fixed by The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Distributors' Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, and computed by adding a percentage margin to the purchase price, are now to be computed by reference to the cash maximum prices set out in the Schedule to this Order.
