THE UTILITY APPAREL (INDUSTRIAL OVERALLS AND MERCHANT  
NAVY UNIFORMS) (DISTRIBUTORS' MAXIMUM PRICES)  
(BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The maximum price to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer on a sale of new utility goods being a garment of any description specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto shall be the appropriate amount specified in that Part in relation to that description, with the addition of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent thereof.
2. The variations of maximum prices specified in Part II of the Schedule hereto shall have effect as therein provided.
3. (1) Each specification number specified or referred to in the second column of Part I of the Schedule hereto refers to utility goods being a garment to which that number (or that number preceded by the letter "Z") has been applied in pursuance of an Order made by the Board of Trade of the United Kingdom.  
(2) Each group number specified in the second column of Section 2 of Part I of the Schedule hereto has the meaning assigned thereto in Part III thereof.
4. (1) In this Order -  
"maximum price" means the price from which the cost actually paid or incurred of delivering those garment may be excluded payable before any deductions by way of discount;  
"utility goods" has the meaning assigned in The Apparel and Textiles (Guernsey) Order, 1945, as amended.  
(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
5. This Order may be cited as The Utility Apparel (Industrial Overalls and Merchant Navy Uniforms) (Distributors' Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 3rd day of March, 1952.

2. Special Garments.

On the sale of a garment which (a) is made to a customer's own measurements, and (b) is marked with the word "special" (or an abbreviation thereof) the appropriate maximum price specified in Part I of this Schedule shall be increased by 25 per cent thereof.

3. Accessories.

On the sale of a garment shown in column 1 of the following table having the feature shown against that garment in column 2, the appropriate maximum price specified in Part I of this Schedule shall be increased by the appropriate amount shown against the garment in column 3.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order fixes retailers' maximum prices for the utility industrial overalls and aprons and Merchant Navy uniforms described in Part I of the Schedule. Hitherto retailers' maximum prices for these goods have been fixed by The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailliwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952. Retailers' maximum prices are now based on the amounts specified in Part I of the Schedule, whereas hitherto they have been fixed by reference to the purchase price and the appropriate margin, subject, in the case of overalls and aprons, to overriding maximum prices. The maximum prices now fixed for overalls and aprons are the same as the former maximum prices specified in Related Schedule No. 5J.
