IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946.

IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949.

AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE.

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated the 3rd August, 1949, (a), as amended, the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick, or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the Board of Administration.

Now, therefore, the Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. The Open General Import Licence dated the 31st October, 1950, as amended, shall be further amended in accordance with the Schedule hereto.
2. This Amendment shall take effect on the 20th day of March, 1952, and may be modified or revoked at any time by the Board of Administration.
