Expired*THE MILK PRICES (GUERNSEY) (NO. 1.) ORDER, 1952.

The States Dairy Committee as Competent Authority in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Order in Council, 1946, and pursuant to a decision of the States of Deliberation of the 19th March, 1952, hereby makes the following Order :-

1. The price payable by the States Dairy Committee (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") in respect of locally produced cows' milk purchased by the Committee and subsequently classified as Grade I milk shall be at the rate of 2s. 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ d. per pot during the period 1st to 30th April, 1952.
2. The price to be paid by retailers to the Committee as regards whole cows' milk, whether produced locally or imported, shall be at the rate of 1s. 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ d. per pot during the period 1st to 30th April, 1952.
3. The price to be paid by consumers to retailers as regards whole cows' milk, whether produced locally or imported and whether delivered at the residence of the consumer or fetched by the consumer, shall be at the rate of 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ d. per pint during the period 1st to 30th April, 1952.
4. This Order may be cited as The Milk Prices (Guernsey) (No. 1.) Order, 1952, and shall have effect from the 1st day of April, 1952.
