THE INFANTS' AND CHILDREN'S GENERAL APPAREL (MAXIMUM  
PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (REVOCATION)  
ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Infants' and Children's General Apparel (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, dated 30th January, 1952 (a), (which fixes maximum prices for infants' and children's non-utility apparel) is hereby revoked.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Infants' and Children's General Apparel (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 26th day of March, 1952.
