THE LINOLEUM AND PRINTED FELT BASE (MAXIMUM PRICES AND CHARGES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Linoleum and Printed Felt Base (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a), as amended (b), shall be further amended as follows:-
 - (1) in the proviso to Article 2 for the words "and Second Schedules" there shall be substituted the word "Schedule";
 - (2) there shall be deleted from paragraph 1 of Article 5 the definition of printed felt base; and
 - (3) the Second Schedule thereto shall be omitted.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Linoleum and Printed Felt Base (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 24th day of March, 1952.
