THE BACON (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT  
NO. 7) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a), as amended (b), shall be further amended by substituting in the Second Column of the Schedule thereto (which specifies the amount of the bacon ration) for the amount "4 oz." in relation to each appropriate coupon in a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 and a Form R.B.12, the amount "5 oz."
2. The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 6) Order, 1952, dated 23rd January, 1952 (c), is hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention of The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, as amended thereby.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
4. This Order may be cited as The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 7) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 23rd day of March, 1952.
