THE EXPORT OF TOMATOES (GRADING) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1952.

THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR HORTICULTURE, under and by virtue of section one of the Export of Tomatoes Law, 1949, as extended by the Export of Tomatoes Law, 1949, (Continuance) Law, 1951, for the purpose of ensuring the orderly and expeditious marketing of tomatoes from Guernsey in 1952, hereby orders:-

1. The Export of Tomatoes (Grading) Order, 1952, is hereby amended as follows:-
 - (a) Paragraphs 5, 6 and 7 shall be renumbered 6, 7 and 8 respectively;
 - (b) the following paragraph shall be inserted after Paragraph 4:-
 - "5. (1) A person shall not export, cause to be exported or attempt to export tomatoes in containers other than containers designed to contain six pounds or twelve pounds of tomatoes.
 - (2) The weight of tomatoes in a container delivered to the Guernsey Tomato Shipping Board for the purpose of export shall -
 - (a) in respect of a container designed to contain six pounds, be not less than six pounds net;
 - (b) in respect of a container designed to contain twelve pounds, be not less than twelve pounds net."
2. This Order shall come into force on the fifteenth day of April, 1952.
