IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949,
AMENDMENT ORDER, 1952

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. There shall be deleted from the Second Schedule of the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a) the following item:-

"Iron and Steel Scrap"

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into force on the 10th day of April, 1952, and may be cited as the "Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment Order, 1952.

The effect of the above Order is that from the 10th April, 1952, Iron and Steel Scrap may be exported without restriction to the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick and the Isle of Man.
